The Rehabilitation Worker II will work with the client on an individual Recovery Plan of Care to address client goals. This position connects with clients living with substance use and receiving services through the Day and Evening Treatment program.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Work as a member of the multidisciplinary team to provide psychosocial rehabilitation services to clients with addiction and mental health disorders.
- Supervise clients living in the community with substance use concerns by promoting a healthy living environment.
- Develop and implement individual routines and programs to support the skill development of clients in accordance with their individual recovery plan.
- Oversee the upkeep of the supportive housing unit to address health and safety of clients.
- Assist clients with developing a monthly budget.
- Encourage client participation in social recreation, vocation, education and wellness programs offered through LLGAMH and other community partners.
- Monitor client compliance with medication regimes.
- Participate in team meetings.
- Provide education to clients regarding home safety practices.
- In consultation members of the team, assist the client in attending scheduled appointments.
- Assist clients who share a supportive housing unit to resolve conflicts as they arise.
